Voter Eligibility: All members voting must be in good standing with the International Association of Machinists and Aerospace Workers as of the date of this election.

Absentee Ballots: See the *District 143 Election Flyer* for the "absentee ballot information," which has the form and procedure for requesting an absentee ballot.

Members who reside in outlying districts more than 25 miles from the designated balloting place, members who are either confined because of verified illness or on leave qualifying under U.S. and Canadian family leave laws, or on vacation, or on official IAM business approved by the Local Lodge, District Lodge, or Grand Lodge, or on employer-travel assignment, or on reserve military leave, as the case may be, shall be furnished absentee ballots.

Requests for an absentee ballot **MUST be made singly**, in writing, by the requesting member and delivered in person or mailed to their local lodge recording secretary (at the address shown on page three of the District 143 Election Flyer.)
